



Dear Community Leader,

I would like to introduce you to the Greater New Orleans Breastfeeding Awareness Coalition (GNOBAC). In July 2007, GNOBAC was created with the mission to increase awareness of the benefits of and support for breastfeeding in the lives of mothers, children and families in Louisiana. GNOBAC also partners with other organizations in creating a community that values the support and promotion of breastfeeding as the standard for optimal infant health and development.

The importance of the promotion of breastfeeding within the New Orleans community can be seen in the positive impact that breastfeeding has on the long term health of both mother and child. The World Health Organization estimates that optimal breastfeeding could save the lives of up to 800,000 children a year. Infants who are breastfed have lower mortality rates, and are less likely to develop gastrointestinal infections. The benefits of breastfeeding continue during childhood and beyond, as infants who breastfeed are less likely to become overweight, develop diabetes, and perform better in school. Mothers who breastfeed are also less likely to develop diabetes, and even reduce their risk of breast and ovarian cancer.[1]

Each year we assist hundreds of women with breastfeeding education and support resources. We have helped educate over 200 local businesses about the Louisiana breastfeeding laws through both direct contact and our local ad campaign, and have expanded our involvement with the Breastfeeding Awareness Campaign. In 2017 the organization plans to create a map of all the breastfeeding resources in the greater New Orleans area, along with collecting valuable input from the community. This will allow for more targeted projects that will effectively address local needs and gaps in educational resources. Without the support of our generous donors we would not be able to ensure that all mothers, children and families in the Greater New Orleans area have the opportunity to receive invaluable information about the benefits of breastfeeding.
